USAGE DIRECTIONS

Dishwash H/D is designed to be used in conjunction with Advantage Chemicals electronic dosing equipment. It can however, also be used in conjunction with integral dosing pumps on dishwashers & traywashers where they are fitted.

The usage concentration range is between 0.08% - 0.30% (0.8 - 3ml/litre) depending on the local area water conditions and soil load present.
