

FOODSAF TABLETS 1g

Foodsaf salad wash tablets

Instructions for the Disinfection of salads, vegetables and non peelable fruit.

- i. Rinse thoroughly in cold water to remove loose soil and insects.
- ii. Prepare disinfecting solution using table below (wear gloves).
- iii. After disinfection remove salad and shake off excess liquid, then transfer to a clean, dry tray and store in a suitable area.
- iv. It is preferable not to rinse after disinfection, unless the food will be consumed within 2 hours, then rinse with clean fresh drinking water.

Ensure complete dissolution of the tablets before completely submerging the salad etc in the solution for the appropriate time. The relationship between contact time and available chlorine is essential.

Dosage - Catering Industry (where there is a short time between preparation and consumption)

Dosage - In Flight Catering & Sandwich Industry (where there is a lengthy time lapse between preparation and consumption)

Advised contact time	15 minutes	10 minutes	5 minutes
